The signif cant issues that require the full at ent on of the organizat on and its stakeholders. The Strategic Priorit es will inform the development of the goals and object ves.

Goals

Goals are statements of what you wish to achieve over the period of the strategic plan. Goals are broad statements that depict the future state or achievement you wish to realize.

Object ves

Object ves are specific statements that contribute to the achievement of goals.
